DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE APR 24 2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING \$15,000 TO SOMALI BANTU ASSOCIATION OF AMERICA FOR THE YOUTH PROGRAM DIRECTOR, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, titled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903 (July 7, 2011); and

WHEREAS, among other things, Council Policy 100-06 provides a procedure and uniform requirements for awarding funds to and contracting with non-profit organizations and public agencies for one-time community, social, environmental, cultural, or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Somali Bantu Association of America has requested funding for the Youth Program Director; and

WHEREAS, the requested funding will be used to cover the salary of the Youth Program Director and associated payroll and administrative costs; and

WHEREAS, the Somali Bantu Association of America request for funding for the Youth Program Director will benefit the public by providing educational, cultural, and life-skills training programs for Somali Bantu refugees, other refugees and at-risk refugee youth, giving them the tools to succeed and become engaged in their communities; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06; and

WHEREAS, Council District 9 recommends an allocation of \$15,000 to the Somali Bantu Association of America for the purposes set forth in this resolution; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocation described in this resolution is made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 3(g), which provides: “An organization may not apply to receive funding for an event or program which has already occurred, nor any capital improvement, goods, supplies, materials, or equipment which have already been purchased.”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 8, which provides: “Community Projects, Programs and Services funding should be considered a one-time resource, and planned uses should be one-time in nature, to avoid service interruptions or employee impacts if funding is discontinued; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a Community Projects, Programs, and Services FY 2018 City Council Allocations Agreement between the City of San Diego and the Somali Bantu Association of America (Agreement) in an amount not to exceed \$15,000 for the project described in this resolution, under terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- **311691** .

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$15,000 from the Community Projects, Programs, and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center 1109110009, GL 512059, to provide funds for the above-referenced Agreement, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or

more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

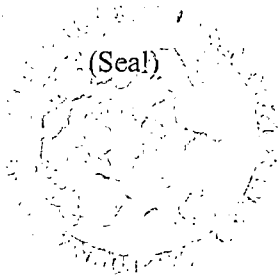
