A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING \$7,000 TO SHERMAN HEIGHTS COMMUNITY CENTER CORPORATION FOR THE CINCO DE MAYO CON ORGULLO FESTIVAL AND CAR SHOW, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-23, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING FOR ARTS, CULTURE AND COMMUNITY FESTIVALS WITH DISCRETIONARY TRANSIENT OCCUPANCY TAX ALLOCATION."

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-23, entitled "City Council Funding of Arts, Culture and Community Festivals with Transient Occupancy Tax Allocation" on August 13, 2012, by San Diego Resolution R-307625; and

WHEREAS, Council Policy 100-23 provides a procedure and uniform requirements for awarding funds to and contracting with private non-profit organizations that produce programs, projects and events that (i) provide access to excellence in culture and the arts for residents of, and visitors to San Diego, and (ii) enrich the lives of the people of San Diego and build healthy, vital neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Sherman Heights Community Center Corporation has requested funding for the Cinco de Mayo con Orgullo Festival and Car Show; and

WHEREAS, the requested funding will be used to schedule activities for people of all ages to enjoy activities such as educational arts workshops, tours of community altar exhibits, a community festival, and a candlelight procession; and

WHEREAS, the Sherman Heights Community Center Corporation's request for funding is for the Cinco de Mayo con Orgullo Festival and Car Show which is an annual community celebration that brings thousands of people of all ages and cultures from around San Diego, Orange County, Los Angeles, and the Baja region to visit Sherman Heights, one of San Diego's

most historic barrios, to enjoy the authentic experience of the Day of the Dead, a tradition celebrated in Mexico. Through workshops, community members learn about different elements of the celebration and have an opportunity to create crafts such as sugar skulls, mini altars, among others. Hundreds of students from schools countywide visit the annual community altar exhibit to gain an understanding of the tradition and receive educational materials that they can share with their families. The Sherman Heights Community Center also engages the community to travel the streets from Sherman Heights to Chicano Park in Barrio Logan, thereby connecting communities and people; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-23; and

WHEREAS, Council District 8 recommends an allocation of \$7,000 to the Sherman Heights Community Center Corporation for the purposes set forth in this resolution; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, an Agreement between the City of San Diego and the Sherman Heights Community Center Corporation (Agreement) in an amount not to exceed \$7,000 for the project described in this resolution, under terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- **311713**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$7,000 from Council District 8: Fund No. 200205, Cost Center 1414111219, to provide funds for the above-referenced Agreement, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-23(3)(g), which provides: "An organization may not apply to receive funding for an event or program which has already occurred, nor any capital improvement, goods, supplies, materials, or equipment which have already been purchased."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that the allocation described herein is made to provide access to culture and the arts for residents of, and visitors to, San Diego, and to enrich the lives of the people of San Diego and build healthy, vital neighborhoods.

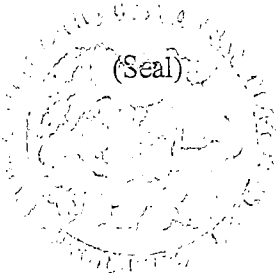
