A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE AGREEMENT WITH HDR INC. TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES TO PREPARE THE RECYCLED WATER SYSTEM CONDITION ASSESSMENT AND OPTIMIZATION PLAN IS STATUTORILY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15262.

WHEREAS, the City's Public Works Department desires to enter into an agreement with HDR Inc., for professional services to prepare the Recycled Water System Condition Assessment and Optimization Plan, in an amount not to exceed \$1,750,000 which consists of three pump stations, two reservoirs, and 96 miles of pipelines and appurtenances (Agreement); and

WHEREAS, the California State Legislature, through the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code sections 21000-21177, has determined that CEQA does not apply to various types of projects listed therein; and

WHEREAS, CEQA section 21084 states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15260-15285 list the statutory exemptions promulgated by the California State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Project is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15262; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, on MAY. 1 5 2018 the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as any public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment because it involves only feasibility or planning studies for possible future actions which the City of San Diego has not approved, adopted, or funded does not require the preparation of an Environmental Impact Report or Negative Declaration but does require consideration of environmental actions; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Project is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15262 (Feasibility and Planning Studies).
