A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ADOPTING THE 2015 UPDATE TO THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTION HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (Public Law 106-390 October 20, 2000) requires all jurisdictions to have an approved hazard mitigation plan in place in order to qualify for hazard mitigation program grants and post disaster mitigation monies; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego County Multi-Jurisdiction Hazard Mitigation Plan (Hazard Mitigation Plan) serves this purpose by identifying the most significant natural hazards and other manmade threats posed to the region, and also specifies goals, objectives, and actions to mitigate the impacts from such hazards for eighteen participating jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the original Hazard Mitigation Plan was approved by the City Council in 2004 and the first revision was approved in 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) requires the Hazard Mitigation Plan to be updated every five years; and

WHEREAS, beginning in summer 2014, the City participated in a required update of the Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the updated plan was completed in late 2015, and reviewed and provisionally approved by FEMA in October 2017; and

WHEREAS, in order to remain eligible for hazard mitigation program grants, post disaster mitigation funds, and California Disaster Assistance Act funding under Assembly Bill 2140, the City must adopt the 2015 update to the Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, failure to adopt the Hazard Mitigation Plan could result in the loss of funding necessary to enhance the City's disaster mitigation efforts, minimize the effects of a major disaster on our communities, and provide vital cost recovery to offset the financial impact of a disaster or catastrophic event; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the 2015 update to the San Diego County Multi-Jurisdiction Hazard Mitigation Plan is adopted in order to remain eligible for hazard mitigation program grants, post disaster mitigation funds, and California Disaster Assistance Act funding under Assembly Bill 2140.
