A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO APPROVE THE PROPOSED 2018 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (RTIP), FIVE YEAR PROGRAM OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019 THROUGH FISCAL YEAR 2023.

WHEREAS, the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) as a Metropolitan Planning Organization and the Regional Transportation Planning Agency is required to develop a Regional Transportation Improvement Plan (RTIP); and

WHEREAS, the RTIP is a multi-year program of proposed projects for major highway, arterial, transit, pedestrian, and bikeway projects including the Transnet program of projects; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Transportation Improvement Ordinance provides that SANDAG periodically approve a multi-year program of eligible projects submitted by local agencies identifying those transportation projects eligible to use transportation sales tax (TransNet) funds; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to submit a proposed 2018 RTIP, Five Year Program of Projects for Fiscal Year 2019 through Fiscal Year 2023 in compliance with San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) Board Policy No. 31 to SANDAG; and

WHEREAS, the current action will also amend the 2016 RTIP to comply with the Fiscal Year 2017 TransNet Audit; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to submit to SANDAG the 2018 update to the Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP) and Five-Year Program of

Projects as required by SANDAG and outlined below and as noted on the Attachments A, B, and C on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR3118342. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to approve adjustments to TransNet-funded projects, according to Attachments D and E, in compliance with SANDAG Board Policy No. 31, Rule #7.

- 3. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to reconcile 2018 RTIP programming of TransNet funds with actual revenue received from the 2016 RTIP in projects in Attachment B as needed.
- 4. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to submit to SANDAG revisions to the 2016 RTIP and to approve adjustments to TransNet-funded projects as required by SANDAG and outlined below and as noted in Attachment D and on Table 1 of Attachment E.
- 5. That pursuant to Section 2(C)(1) of the TransNet Extension Ordinance, the City of San Diego certifies that no more than 30 percent of its cumulative revenues shall be spent on local street and road maintenance-related projects.
- 6. That pursuant to Section 4(E)(3) of the TransNet Extension Ordinance, the City of San Diego certifies that all new projects, or major reconstruction projects, funded by TransNet revenues shall accommodate travel by pedestrians and bicyclists, and that any exception to this requirement permitted under the Ordinance and proposed, shall be clearly noticed as part of the City of San Diego's public hearing process.
- 7. That pursuant to Section 8 of the TransNet Extension Ordinance, the City of San Diego certifies that the required minimum annual level of local discretionary funds to be expended for street and road purposes will be met throughout the five-year period consistent with the most recent Maintenance of Effort Requirements adopted by SANDAG.

8. That pursuant to Section 9A of the TransNet Extension Ordinance, the City of San

Diego certifies that it will exact \$2,483.48, plus all applicable annual increases, from the private

sector for each newly constructed residential housing unit in that jurisdiction (unless exempted

under the TransNet Extension Ordinance), and shall contribute such exactions to the Regional

Transportation Congestion Improvement Program (RTCIP).

9. That pursuant to Section 13 of the TransNet Extension Ordinance, the City of San

Diego certifies that it has established a separate Transportation Improvement Account for

TransNet revenues with interest earned expended only for those purposes for which the funds

were allocated.

10. That pursuant to Section 18 of the TransNet Extension Ordinance, the City of San

Diego certifies that each project of \$250,000 or more will be clearly designated during

construction with TransNet project funding identification signs.

11. That the City of San Diego certifies that all other applicable provisions of the

TransNet Extension Ordinance and SANDAG Board Policy No. 31 have been met.

12. That the City of San Diego agrees to indemnify, hold harmless, and defend

SANDAG, the San Diego County Regional Transportation Commission, and all officers and

employees thereof against all causes of action or claims related to City of San Diego TransNet-

funded projects.
