A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE ANNUAL REPORTS SUBMITTED IN CONNECTION WITH THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019 AND RELATED FUNDING ACTIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. Each Fiscal Year 2019 Annual Report submitted for the Parks & Rec MADs, on file and available for review in the Office of the City Clerk as listed above, is approved as filed.
- 2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate, transfer, and expend District funds, including the management fund, district operating funds, district capital funds, and developer deposit funds associated with new District formation activities for Fiscal Year 2019, contingent upon approval of the Fiscal Year 2019 Appropriation Ordinance, and contingent upon the City Comptroller certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are or will be available.
- 3. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to manually bill and collect assessments which are not billed by the County of San Diego, in the same time and manner as county taxes

are collected, and all laws providing for the collection and enforcement of county taxes shall apply to the collection and enforcement of the assessments.
