A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE REPORT SUBMITTED IN CONNECTION WITH THE NORTH PARK PROPERTY AND BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019 AND RELATED FUNDING ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, the Property and Business Improvement District Law of 1994, California Streets and Highways Code sections 36600-36671 (PBID Law), authorizes cities and counties to establish and renew property and business improvement districts for the purpose of promoting economic revitalization and physical maintenance of improvements; and

WHEREAS, on July 11, 2017, the City Council adopted Resolution R-311234

(Resolution of Formation), forming the North Park Property and Business Improvement District

(North Park PBID) for a term of five years in accordance with PBID Law; and

WHEREAS, the Resolution of Formation approved the Management District Plan, which includes an engineer's report, a management plan, and the assessments described therein, for the period of January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2022, a copy of which is on file with the City Clerk as Document No. RR-311234-1; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code section 36651, the Management District Plan states that North Park Main Street, a nonprofit corporation (NPMS), will manage the North Park PBID and provide the improvements, maintenance, and activities described in the Management District Plan pursuant to an operating agreement between the City and NPMS; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code section 36625(b), the adoption of the Resolution of Formation constituted the levy of the assessments beginning

January 1, 2018 and ending on December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code section 36650, a written report for Fiscal Year 2019 (Report) has been prepared for the North Park PBID; and

WHEREAS, the Report conforms to the above-referenced authority and has been duly considered by the Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The Fiscal Year 2019 Report submitted for the North Park PBID, on file and available for review in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-311890 is approved as filed.
- 2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate, transfer, and expend funds in an amount not to exceed \$308,899 from North Park PBID Operating Funds, Fund 200734, for the operation and administration costs in the Fiscal Year 2019 Report, contingent upon the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2019 Appropriation Ordinance and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing a certificate certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
- 3. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate, transfer, and expend any monies deposited in the North Park PBID Operating Fund, Fund 200734, in excess of estimated revenue and any carryover monies from the previous fiscal year, contingent upon the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2019 Appropriation Ordinance and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing a certificate certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

- 4. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend funds in an amount not to exceed \$11,322 from the General Fund for the purpose of paying the assessments levied upon City-owned parcels within the North Park PBID for FY 2019, contingent upon the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2019 Appropriation Ordinance and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing a certificate certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
- 5. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend \$12,356 from North Park PBID Operating Fund, Fund 200734, for the City's administration of the North Park PBID for Fiscal Year 2019, contingent upon the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2019 Appropriation Ordinance and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing a certificate certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
- 6. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend funds in an amount not to exceed \$4,366 from the Gas Tax Fund, Fund 200118, for the purpose of costs associated with median maintenance within the North Park PBID for FY 2019, contingent upon the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2019 Appropriation Ordinance and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing a certificate certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
- 7. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to manually bill and collect assessments for the North Park PBID which are not billed by the County of San Diego, in the same time and

manner as county taxes are collected, and all laws providing for the collection and enforcement of county taxes shall apply to the collection and enforcement of the assessments.
