

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 311892DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUL 17 2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE
MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO ON JUNE 5, 2018.

WHEREAS, a Municipal Primary Election was held in the City of San Diego on Tuesday, June 5, 2018, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. O-20909 (New Series), introduced and adopted on February 26, 2018, for the purpose of electing candidates to the offices of Councilmember for Districts 2, 4, 6, and 8, respectively; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Charter section 10 directs that the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes in a race for Councilmember for a specific district are to be declared as such, and then will advance to the Municipal General Election for the office; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the certificate of the Registrar of Voters of San Diego County canvassing the returns of the Municipal Primary Election, as certified to the City Clerk, has been duly received; and

WHEREAS, a canvass of this election has been completed and the City Clerk has certified the results to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, declaring the results of the election as certified by the Registrar of Voters and the City Clerk is a ministerial act required by California Elections Code section 10263 and, therefore, is not subject to veto by the Mayor; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Council finds and determines, pursuant to the provisions of Section 27.0411 of the San Diego Municipal Code, as follows:

I

The total number of votes cast in the City was 103,013.

II

The total vote received by each municipal candidate at the Municipal Primary Election is as follows:

A. FOR COUNCIL DISTRICT 2 (four-year term)

Lorie Zapf and Jennifer Campbell are hereby declared to be the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes and will advance to the Municipal General Election for the office of Councilmember, District No. 2.

B. FOR COUNCIL DISTRICT 4 (four-year term)

MONICA MONTGOMERY	7,424 VOTES (38.82%)
MYRTLE COLE	7,418 VOTES (38.79%)
TONY VILAFRANCA	3,273 VOTES (17.12%)
NEAL ARTHUR	978 VOTES (5.11%)
Total	19,093 VOTES (100%)

Monica Montgomery and Myrtle Cole are hereby declared to be the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes and will advance to the Municipal General Election for the office of Councilmember, District No. 4.

C. FOR COUNCIL DISTRICT 6 (four-year term)

TOMMY HOUGH	4,728 VOTES (17.37%)
MATT VALENTI	2,655 VOTES (9.76%)
FAYAZ NAWABI	1,838 VOTES (6.75%)
JEREMIAH BLATTLER	1,490 VOTES (5.48%)
KEVIN LEE EGGER	1,111 VOTES (4.08%)
Total	27,138 VOTES (100%)

Chris Cate and Tommy Hough are hereby declared to be the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes and will advance to the Municipal General Election for the office of Councilmember, District No. 6.

D. FOR COUNCIL DISTRICT 8 (four-year term)

VIVIAN MORENO	5,327 VOTES (35.60%)
ANTONIO MARTINEZ	4,087 VOTES (27.31%)
CHRISTIAN RAMIREZ	4,084 VOTES (27.29%)
ZACHARY LAZARUS	1,365 VOTES (9.12%)
Total	14,863 VOTES (100%)

Vivian Moreno and Antonio Martinez are hereby declared to be the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes and will advance to the Municipal General Election for the office of Councilmember, District No. 8.

The City Clerk shall make public the results of the canvass of the election by publication of a copy of this resolution.
