A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATIONS TO CALRECYCLE FOR THE ILLEGAL DISPOSAL SITE ABATEMENT GRANT PROGRAM AND TAKING RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, California Public Resources Code sections 48000 *et seq.* authorize the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to administer various grant programs in furtherance of the State of California's efforts to reduce, recycle, and reuse solid waste generated in the state, thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety, and the environment; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority, CalRecycle has established procedures governing the application, awarding, and management of such grants; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle's grant application procedures require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to submit applications to CalRecycle for the Illegal Disposal Site Abatement Grant Program, for Fiscal Year 2018/2019 through and including Fiscal Year 2023/2024, for up to \$500,000 annually, to receive funds for supporting the City of San Diego's waste abatement programs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to negotiate and execute, for and on behalf of the City, all grant documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, and requests for payment, which are necessary

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to secure grant funds from CalRecycle and support the approved grant project, for Fiscal Year

2018/2019 through and including Fiscal Year 2023/2024.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept

the awarded CalRecycle grant funds, contingent upon securing the awarded funds and notice of

award.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to

appropriate and expend the awarded funds, solely and exclusively for the City of San Diego's

waste abatement activities in accordance with the CalRecycle Illegal Disposal Site Abatement

Grant Program requirements, contingent upon securing the awarded funds and notice of award.
