A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATIONS TO CALRECYCLE FOR THE ILLEGAL DISPOSAL SITE ABATEMENT GRANT PROGRAM AND TAKING RELATED ACTIONS IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15308.

WHEREAS, California Public Resources Code sections 48000 *et seq.* authorize the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to administer various grant programs in furtherance of the State of California's efforts to reduce, recycle, and reuse solid waste generated in the state, thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety, and the environment; and

WHEREAS, the City's submittal of applications to CalRecycle for the Illegal Disposal Site Abatement Grant Program, and related actions, will allow the City to receive grant funds to support the City's waste abatement activities for Fiscal Year 2018/2019 through and including Fiscal Year 2023/2024 (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (California Public Resources Code sections 21000 *et seq.*), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, sections 15000 *et seq.*) shall list those classes of projects that have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and that shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300 through 15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research

and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects that have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the City's Development Services Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15308, and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and


WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment as the Project consists of actions to secure grant funding that will support the City's waste abatement activities, and thus will serve to maintain, restore, enhance, or protect the environment; NOW

THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15308.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.




