A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO PREPARE A BALLOT TITLE AND SUMMARY AND AN IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS; AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, INDEPENDENT BUDGET ANALYST AND CITY AUDITOR TO PREPARE A FISCAL IMPACT ANALYSIS; ALL REGARDING ONE MEASURE, TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AT THE MUNICIPAL SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 6, 2018, AMENDING THE CITY CHARTER BY AMENDING ARTICLE III, SECTION 12(c), RELATING TO TERM LIMITS FOR COUNCILMEMBERS.

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code section 27.0504 allows the City Council to direct the City Attorney to prepare a ballot title and summary of any proposed ballot measure; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code section 27.0505 allows the City Council to direct the City Attorney to prepare an impartial analysis of any proposed ballot measure; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code section 27.0506 directs the Independent Budget Analyst, working with the Mayor (or his or her designee) and the City Auditor, to prepare a fiscal impact analysis of a proposed legislative act; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting held on July 30, 2018, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. **0-20971**, to place on the November 6, 2018, Municipal Special Election ballot, one measure amending the City Charter by amending Article III, section 12(c), relating to term limits for Councilmembers; and

WHEREAS, the Charter amendment measure was proposed by Council President

Pro Tem Barbara Bry and Councilmember Chris Ward through the Council Policy 000-21

process, heard by the Rules Committee, and then considered by the Council for placement on the ballot; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Charter section 295(d), this resolution relating to matters to submit to City voters at a Municipal Special Election is not subject to veto by the Mayor, and thus the date of its passage by the Council shall be deemed the date of final passage; NOW,

THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The City Attorney is directed to prepare a ballot title and summary, and an impartial analysis, of the proposed ballot measure for inclusion in the voter pamphlet and to deliver the ballot title and summary, and the impartial analysis, to the Office of the City Clerk,

Elections Section, no later than August 20, 2018.

2. The Independent Budget Analyst, working with the Mayor (or the Mayor's designee) and the City Auditor, is directed to prepare a fiscal impact analysis of the proposed ballot measure for inclusion in the voter pamphlet and to deliver the analysis to the Office of the City Clerk, Elections Section, no later than August 20, 2018.
