A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH SCS ENGINEERS, INC. TO PERFORM INTERIM OPERATIONS, MAINTENANCE, AND GAS SUPPLY SERVICES AT THE MIRAMAR LANDFILL.

WHEREAS, the City operates the Miramar Landfill pursuant to a lease with the Unites States Department of the Navy (Navy) and has the responsibilities associated with controlling methane gas created by landfilling operations (Landfill Gas); and

WHEREAS, in 1998 the rights to the Landfill Gas were subleased by the City to NEO San Diego, LLC, which harvested gas for commercial purposes (NEO SD Gas Lease); and

WHEREAS, NEO San Diego, LLC currently performs operations and maintenance services for the Landfill Gas Collection System, however, the NEO SD Gas Lease will terminate on December 31, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City is in the process of competitive solicitation for the long-term privatized operation and maintenance of the Landfill Gas Collection System and for the development of additional Landfill Gas fueled electric generating capacity; and

WHEREAS, the competitive process for the long-term privatization project will not be completed by the December 31, 2018 termination date of the NEO Gas SD Lease, and may not be completed before January 2020; and

WHEREAS, until the competitive process is complete, interim technical services are needed for the operation and maintenance of the Landfill Gas Collection System; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his

designee, is authorized to execute an agreement with SCS Engineers, Inc. to provide interim

operation, maintenance, and gas supply services at the Miramar Landfill, in the amount not to

exceed \$2,000,000 for a two-year period, as provided in the document on file in the Office of the

City Clerk as Document No. R R.311925

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to

appropriate and expend funds in the amount not to exceed \$1,000,000 annually over two years

from the Refuse Disposal Enterprise Fund 700039 for the interim Landfill Gas Collection

System operations, maintenance, and gas supply services at the Miramar Landfill, contingent

upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal years, and

contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying

that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
