A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO REALLOCATE, APPROPRIATE, AND EXPEND FUNDS IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 PARKS AND RECREATION CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BUDGET IS EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15061(B)(3).

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), states that CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3) states the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego desires to reallocate, appropriate, and expend \$1.8 million of Regional Park Improvement Funds and Environmental Growth Funds allocated within the Fiscal Year 2019 Parks and Recreation Capital Improvement Budget to the Ladera Street Beach Access Stairway Emergency Project (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has established that the approval of the Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3); and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the potential environmental effect of the reallocation, appropriation, and expenditure of \$1.8 million of Regional Park Improvement Funds and Environmental Growth Funds allocated within the Fiscal Year 2019 Parks and Recreation Capital Improvement Budget to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has considered the written record and public comment for City staff's request to reallocate, appropriate, and expend \$1.8 million of Regional Park Improvement Funds and Environmental Growth Funds allocated within the Fiscal Year 2019 Parks and Recreation Capital Improvement Budget to the Ladera Street Beach Access Stairway Emergency Project, and determines that the Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3), under the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment.
