A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL OF A TWENTY-YEAR LEASE BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND LA JOLLA COMMUNITY CENTER FOR CITY-OWNED REAL PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE FLORENCE RIFORD SENIOR SERVICES CENTER LOCATED AT 6811 LA JOLLA BOULEVARD, LA JOLLA, CALIFORNIA IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM CEQA PURSUANT TO SECTION 15301 AND SECTION 15323 OF THE STATE CEQA GUIDELINES.

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego desires to authorize a twenty-year Lease with La Jolla Community Center, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 311935, for the real property commonly known as the Florence Riford Senior Services Center located at 6811 La Jolla Boulevard, La Jolla, California and described in the Lease (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Project is

categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15301 and 15323 and

that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to

the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) has considered the potential

environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written

record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project

will not have a significant effect on the environment because in involves the operation and

leasing of an existing facility for which the facility was designed, with negligible or no

expansion of the use of the property; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the Project

is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15301 and 15323,

and that an exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, does

not apply.
