A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXECUTION OF THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AIRSPACE GROUND LEASE WITH THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, FOR THE REAL PROPERTY LOCATED AT 299 17TH STREET, SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, KNOWN AS THE NEIL GOOD DAY CENTER, IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15301.

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) desires to authorize the execution of the First Amendment to the State of California, Department of Transportation Airspace Ground Lease, with the State of California, acting by and through the Department of Transportation, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR
311954, to extend the term of the State of California Department of Transportation Airspace Ground Lease by 2 years to a total term of thirty-two (32) years for the real property located at 299 17th Street, San Diego, California (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has established that the Project is categorically

exempt from CEOA pursuant to CEOA Guidelines section 15301 (Existing Facilities) in that the

Project entails the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, and minor

alterations of existing facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use, and that no

exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the

Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) has considered the potential

environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written

record for the Project as well as public comment; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent

judgment, has considered the written record and public comment concerning the request that the

Mayor, or his designee, be authorized to execute the First Amendment to the State of California,

Department of Transportation Airspace Ground Lease, with the State of California, acting by and

through the Department of Transportation, and determines that the Project is categorically

exempt from CEOA pursuant to CEOA Guidelines section 15301, and that an exception to the

exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
