A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT APPROVAL OF A STREET NAME CHANGE FOR A ONE-BLOCK PORTION OF PARK BOULEVARD BETWEEN IMPERIAL AVENUE AND TONY GWYNN DRIVE TO TREVOR HOFFMAN WAY IS EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO SECTION 15301 OF THE CEQA GUIDELINES.

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (California Public Resources Code section 21000, *et seq.*), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, section 15000, *et seq.*) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego desires to change the street name for a one-block portion of Park Boulevard between Imperial Avenue and Tony Gwynn Drive Trevor Hoffman Way (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Analysis Section of the Development Services

Department has established that the Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines

Section 15301 and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section

15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential

environmental effects and considerations of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the

written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has

determined that the Project is exempt from CEQA, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section

15282(h); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent

judgment, has considered the written record and public comment for the requested authorization,

and determines that the Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section

15301.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has

determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2

does not apply.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of

Exemption regarding the Project with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of

San Diego.
