A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT APPROVAL OF THE JOINT USE AGREEMENT WITH THE SAN DIEGO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR HARRIET TUBMAN CHARTER SCHOOL IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTIONS 15301, 15303(e), 15304(b), 15311, AND 15314.

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), states that CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300 – 15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) desires to authorize the execution of that certain Agreement for the Construction, Operation, Maintenance, and Use of Joint Use Facilities at Harriet Tubman Charter School between the City and the San Diego Unified School District, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. 00-21007, for the joint use of a portion of Harriet Tubman Charter School (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has established that the approval of the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15301 (Existing Facilities), 15303(e) (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures), 15304(b) Minor

Alterations to Land), 15311 (Accessory Structures), and 15314 (Minor Alterations to Schools), and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) has considered the potential environmental effect of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment because it is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the Project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the California Government Code; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301, 15303(e), 15304(b), 15311, and 15314, and that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
