A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING A SEVENTH AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH IMS RECYCLING SERVICES AND ALLAN COMPANY FOR PROCESSING, TRANSPORTING AND MARKETING COMMINGLED CURBSIDE RECYCLABLES.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) requires the continued services of a contractor to process, transport, and market the recyclable materials collected in the City's curbside recycling program; and

WHEREAS, in October 1998, after completion of a competitive request for proposal process, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) authorized a revenue-generating agreement with IMS Recycling Services and Allan Company (Contractor) to process, transport, and market the recyclables collected by the City in its curbside recycling program (Agreement); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Agreement, the Council authorized five subsequent amendments to modify and extend the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Sixth Amendment modified the Agreement to adjust the revenue sharing provisions, in order to address Contractor's material and adverse processing or operational cost increases, in accordance with Section 3.0, subsection 3.15 of the Agreement, due to mandatory state and local minimum wage increases; and

WHEREAS, the City and Contractor have negotiated certain amendments to sections of the Agreement, in order to address Contractor's material and adverse processing or operational cost increases, in accordance with Section 3.0, subsection 3.15 of the Agreement, due to China's implementation of its National Sword policy, which banned the importation of certain recyclable

commodities, particularly mixed paper, plastics and metals; imposed unprecedented lower

allowances for contaminants that are much stricter than international standards; and significantly

cut back on the import volume and increased inspections of recyclable commodity imports; and

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2018, the Environmental Committee unanimously

recommended approval of this item; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his

designee is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a seventh amendment to the

Agreement with IMS Recycling Services and Allan Company to process, transport, and market

recyclable materials collected in the City's curbside recycling program, under the terms and

conditions set forth in the Seventh Amendment, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as
