A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CONFIRMING THE CITY'S CONSENT TO THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO PROVIDING PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES WITHIN THE CITY.

WHEREAS, California Health and Safety Code sections 101375-101380 authorize the governing body of a city to consent, by resolution or ordinance, to the county health officer's enforcement and observation of orders and quarantine regulations prescribed by the State Department of Public Health, regulations issued under the Health and Safety Code, and statutes relating to the public health; and

WHEREAS, in 1953, by adoption of Resolution R-110405, the Council of the City of San Diego authorized that certain Basic Agreement for Public Health Services to be Furnished by the County to the City of San Diego (Basic Agreement) consistent with the provisions of Health and Safety Code sections 476-477 (the prior versions of current Health and Safety Code sections 101375-101380); and

WHEREAS, the Basic Agreement was superseded by that certain Second Basic Agreement for Public Health Services to be Furnished by the County to the City of San Diego, authorized by Resolution R-218878 in 1977 (Second Basic Agreement); and

WHEREAS, the Second Basic Agreement requires the County to "enforce and observe in the City... [a]ll orders, quarantine regulations, and rules and regulations issued by the State Department of Public Health under the provisions of the Health and Safety Code of the State of California" and all state statutes relating to public health; and

WHEREAS, the Second Basic Agreement is still in full force and effect; and

WHEREAS, the Grand Jury recently released a report entitled "The San Diego Hepatitis

A Epidemic: (Mis) Handling A Public Health Crisis," requesting the City reaffirm the authority

of the County pursuant to Health and Safety Code sections 101375-101380; and

WHEREAS, the City complied with those sections by authorizing the Basic Agreement

and Second Basic Agreement, each by resolution; and

WHEREAS, although not legally required, the City desires to nonetheless reaffirm its

compliance with Health and Safety Code sections 101375-101380; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City reaffirms its

existing contractual relationship with the County of San Diego pursuant to California Health and

Safety Code sections 101375-101380, as established by Resolution R- 218878 and the Second

Basic Agreement for Public Health Services to be Furnished by the County to the City of San

Diego dated October 18, 1977.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to the Second Basic Agreement and Health

and Safety Code section 101380, the Council's consent to the County's provision of public

health services within the City will continue indefinitely and no additional action is required by

the City.
