ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 21032 (NEW SERIES)

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JAN 11 2019

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE COOPERATIVE PROCUREMENT CONTRACT WITH INSIGHT PUBLIC SECTOR, INC. FOR TECHNOLOGY PRODUCTS, SERVICES, SOLUTIONS AND RELATED PRODUCTS AND SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the County of Fairfax, as lead agency for a U.S. Communities cooperative procurement, issued a Request for Proposals for the provision of Technology Products, Services, Solutions, and Related Products and Services by posting the solicitation on the County of Fairfax website, the U.S. Communities website, and in the Hawaii Tribune-Herald and the Daily Journal of Commerce in Oregon and, on February 22, 2016, executed a contract with Insight Public Services, Inc. (Insight) identified as Contract Number 4400006644; and

WHEREAS, as provided for in Section 22.3208 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the City's Purchasing Agent certified in writing that use of the Insight cooperative procurement contract was in the City's best interests, to the City's economic advantage, and the agency's contract was awarded using a process that complies with the City's policies, rules, and regulations; and

WHEREAS, on May 3, 2017, the City of San Diego entered into a Cooperative Procurement Contract with Insight for the provision of Technology Products, Services, Solutions and Related Products and Services (Contract) with an initial term extending through April 30, 2019 with four (4) one-year options that could be exercised by the Mayor or his designee, contingent on approval of an ordinance as required under the Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Information Technology is requesting approval of an Ordinance authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute the First Amendment to the Cooperative Procurement Contract with Insight Public Services, Inc. for the provision of Technology Products, Services, Solutions and Related Products and Services (First Amendment), to increase the not-to-exceed amount of the Contract to a total of \$10,600,000 (pursuant to the requirements in the First Amendment); and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement, or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by Ordinance approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, the First Amendment to the Cooperative Procurement Contract between the City of San Diego and Insight Public Sector, Inc. for the provision of Technology Products, Services, Solutions and Related Products and Services, to increase the not-to-exceed amount of the Contract by \$4,000,000 (to increase the total not to exceed amount from \$3,000,000 to \$7,000,000) during the term of the Agreement extending from the Effective Date through April 30, 2021 (subject to the City's exercise of its options during that period) and by an additional amount not to exceed \$1,800,000, for a total not to exceed amount of \$8,800,000, contingent upon the County of Fairfax extending the Agreement through April 30, 2022 (and contingent on the City exercising its option for that period), and an additional amount not to exceed \$1,800,000, for a total not to exceed amount of \$10,600,000, contingent upon the County of Fairfax extending the Agreement through April 30, 2023 (and contingent on the City

exercising its option for that period) pursuant to the terms and conditions contained in the First Amendment to the original Contract on file with the City Clerk as Document No.



Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$7,000,000 during the term of the Agreement extending from the Effective Date through April 30, 2021 (subject to the City's exercise of its options during that period) and by an additional amount not to exceed \$1,800,000, for a total not to exceed amount of \$8,800,000, contingent upon the County of Fairfax extending the Agreement through April 30, 2022 (and contingent on the City exercising its option for that period), and an additional amount not to exceed \$1,800,000, for a total not to exceed amount of \$10,600,000 over the term of the Contract, contingent upon the County of Fairfax extending the Agreement through April 30, 2023 (and contingent on the City exercising its option for that period), contingent upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
