AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO A REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT WITH KILROY REALTY CORPORATION FOR TORREY MEADOWS DRIVE (FORMERLY STREET "B") OVERCROSSING DESIGN WORK IN THE TORREY HIGHLANDS COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, on May 16, 2013, the City and Kilroy Realty Corporation, a California corporation (Developer), entered into that certain Reimbursement Agreement No.

RR-308126 (Agreement) for the Torrey Meadows Drive (formerly Street "B") Overcrossing (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement allows for Developer to complete the design of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the original term of the Agreement was five years; and

WHEREAS, due to unforeseen delays, including additional time required to obtain the Mitigated Negative Declaration, the Developer requests an extension of time to complete the design of the Project; and

WHEREAS, to reflect the additional time, the City and Developer have negotiated the proposed First Amendment to Reimbursement Agreement, a copy of which is included in the backup materials accompanying this Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the revision will extend the term of the Agreement beyond five years; and WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by Ordinance approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. The First Amendment to Reimbursement Agreement is approved.

Section 2. The Mayor or designee is authorized and directed, on behalf of the City, to sign and enter into the First Amendment to Reimbursement Agreement, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 21037.

Section 3. A full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
