ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 21051 (NEW SERIES)

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAR 13 2019

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE AWARD AND EXECUTION OF AN AS-NEEDED ENGINEERING CONSULTANT CONTRACT TO DOKKEN ENGINEERING FOR THE DESIGN OF ALVARADO CANYON ROAD REALIGNMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) is proposing to realign Alvarado Canyon Road, which is located in the central portion of the City, in the Navajo community. The purpose of Alvarado Canyon Road Realignment Project is to alleviate current and projected future traffic congestion on Alvarado Canyon Road and Mission Gorge Road adjacent to the Interstate 8 Intersection; and

WHEREAS, the Project site is on the north side of Interstate-8 (I-8) and encompasses the intersections of Alvarado Canyon Road / Mission Gorge Road and Mission Gorge Road / Fairmount Avenue. The street segments between these intersections, as well as portions of Alvarado Canyon Road and Fairmount Avenue, are also proposed to be improved as part of the Project. Presently, Alvarado Canyon Road is a two-lane collector with a west bound off-ramp from I-8 that connects to Mission Gorge Road; and

WHEREAS, the City is proposing to abandon the existing Alvarado Canyon Road connection to the west bound off ramp and realign it to connect directly to Mission Gorge Road at the existing Fairmont Avenue intersection; and

WHEREAS, the City issued a Request for Proposal (H187015) to solicit engineering services for the Project. Six firms submitted proposals. Dokken Engineering was selected based upon their qualifications in accordance with Council Policy 300-07; and

WHEREAS, the contract will retain the services of Dokken Engineering to provide professional design services on an as-needed, hourly fee basis. The terms of this contract will be no longer than eight years at a cost of \$3,500,000.00, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, under San Diego Charter section 99, a supermajority vote of the City Council is required for passage of this ordinance; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

Section 1. Authorize the change of name for CIP P-18007, Alvarado Road Alignment, to Alvarado Canyon Road Realignment.

Section 2. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute an agreement with Dokken Engineering to provide as-needed engineering design services in an amount not to exceed \$3,500,000.00, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer; under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. 00-21051.


Section 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$3,500,000.00 over eight years for the purpose of funding the as-needed engineering design service agreement with Dokken Engineering, contingent upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

Section 4. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$1,000.00 in CIP P-18007, Alvarado Canyon Road Realignment, Fund 200636, Developer Contributions CIP, for the purpose of executing this consultant agreement and meeting minimum contract requirements.

Section 5. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 6. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
