AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE 3, DIVISION 00 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 63.20; AMENDING SECTION 63.20.3; AMENDING SECTION 63.20.22; AND AMENDING SECTION 63.25.1 RELATING TO ANCHORING OR MOORING IN ZUNIGA JETTY SHOALS AND OTHER WATERS WITHIN THE CITY'S JURISDICTION.

WHEREAS, the City's jurisdictional waters encompass the area east of the Zuniga Jetty in the Pacific Ocean, known as the Zuniga Jetty Shoals; and

WHEREAS, vessels abandoned in the Zuniga Jetty Shoals may leave debris and hazardous materials on the shore and in the water and may pose a threat to the public's health safety; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to prevent the abandonment of such and wishes to hold accountable those who do not abide by City regulations; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 6, Article 3, Division 00 is amended by amending section 63.20, to read as follows:

§63.20 Beach Areas — Authority and Control

(a) The Park and Recreation Department of the City of San Diego shall have jurisdiction and control over all beaches owned or controlled by the City of San Diego and all waters abutting or adjacent to them within the limits of the City of San Diego, and of all lands owned or controlled by the City, adjoining the waterfront of the Pacific Ocean and the waters of Mission Bay, and it shall be responsible for the control and management of these

- beaches and lands, and waters abutting or adjacent to them, and of the recreational activities on them.
- (b) Throughout this Division, the term "beach area" means any beach or land and the waters abutting or adjacent thereto under the jurisdiction and control of the Park and Recreation Department, as set forth in paragraph (a) of this section.
- (c) Throughout this Division, the term "vessel" has the same meaning as in the California Harbors and Navigation Code.

Section 2. That Chapter 6, Article 3, Division 00 is amending by amending section 63.20.3, to read as follows:

§63.20.3 Warning Signals

- (a) It is unlawful for any person to bathe, swim, surfboard ride, row, canoe, or operate a sailboat or power boat or similar device on or upon water when warning signals have been placed on or upon that water or the adjacent beach area except for the purpose of making a rescue.
- (b) It is unlawful for any person to operate a vessel, or a windsurfer, sailboard, or similar device within a swimming area which has been marked by means of buoys or to operate same within one hundred (100) feet of such area at a speed in excess of five (5) miles per hour.

Section 3. That Chapter 6, Article 3, Division 00 is amending by amending section 63.20.22, to read as follows:

§63.20.22 Abandoning Boats and Other Property Prohibited, Mooring and Anchorage Regulated

- (a) Except as otherwise permitted by this Code and except as may be permitted by the Director, it is unlawful:
 - (1) To allow vessels, boats, vehicles, or trailers to remain unattended in any beach area, including the waters thereof and Mission Bay Park.
 - (2) To moor or anchor any vessel, or for the owner of a vessel to allow that vessel to be moored or anchored, whether occupied or unoccupied, between the hours of ten (10:00) o'clock p.m. and seven (7:00) o'clock a.m. in any area of Mission Bay Park.
 - (3) To moor or anchor any vessel, or for the owner of a vessel to allow that vessel to be moored or anchored, and leave that vessel unoccupied for more than two hours in Zuniga Jetty Shoals. For purposes of section 63.20.22, Zuniga Jetty Shoals means the area within the following Global Positioning System coordinates:

- (b) Any vessel, boat, vehicle, or trailer left in violation of Section 63.20.22(a) may be removed by the Director without notice and any cost of removal and storage of that property may be recovered by the City of San Diego from the owner or any other person responsible for a violation of section 63.20.22. Nothing in this section will prevent impounding of a vessel as may be authorized by the California Harbors and Navigation Code or by this Code.
- (c) Upon impounding a boat or vessel under the authority of subsection 63.20.22(b), the Director will, within ten calendar days of the impounding, send a registered notification letter to the owner of record advising of the impounding and what actions the owner may take to reclaim the property. If inadequate identifying information is available on the impounded property, no notification is required. If the owner of the property fails to appear and pay all fees owed the City within thirty calendar days of the impounding of the property, the property will be subject to removal, destruction, sale, or other disposal by the Director at the expense of the owner and without any liability to the City for any damage to any property of the owner.
- (d) Any sunken or abandoned vessels, rafts, wharves, buildings, or other obstructions found upon any beach area within the City of San Diego, including the waters thereof and Mission Bay Park, may be removed, destroyed, sold, or otherwise disposed of by the Director at the expense of

the owner and without any liability to the City for any damage to any

property of the owner.

(e) The City may recover from the owner of any vessel, boat, vehicle, trailer,

raft, wharf, building, or obstruction all City costs incurred as a result of

any violations of this section, including costs associated with the clean-up

or repair of damaged City property.

Section 4. That Chapter 6, Article 3, Division 00 is amending by amending section

63.25.1, to read as follows:

§63.25.1 Same — Definitions

"Commercial Vessel" through "Personal Watercraft" [No change in text.]

"Vessel" has the same meaning as in the California Harbors and Navigation Code.

"Waters of Mission Bay" [No change in text.]

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a

written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its

passage.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from

and after its final passage.

§63.20 Beach Areas — Authority and Control

- (a) The Park and Recreation Department of Thethe City of San Diego shall have jurisdiction and control over all beaches owned or controlled by Thethe City of San Diego and all waters abutting or adjacent theretoto them within the limits of Thethe City of San Diego, and of all lands heretofore and hereafter owned or controlled by the City, adjoining the waterfront of the Pacific Ocean and the waters of Mission Bay, and it shall be responsible for the control and management of saidthese beaches and lands, and waters abutting or adjacent theretoto them, and of the recreational activities thereon and thereinon them.
- (b) In the following sections dealing with the same subject, wherever the context thereof shall permit, Throughout this Division, the term "beach area" shall means any beach or land and the waters abutting or adjacent

- thereto under the jurisdiction and control of the Park and Recreation

 Department, as set forth in paragraph (a) of this section.
- (c) Throughout this Division, the term "vessel" has the same meaning as in the California Harbors and Navigation Code.

§63.20.3 Warning Signals

- (a) It is unlawful for any person to bathe, swim, surfboard ride, row, canoe, or operate a sailboat or power boat or othersimilar device on or upon water when warning signals have been placed on or upon saidthat water or the adjacent beach area except for the purpose of making a rescue.
- (b) It is unlawful for any person to operate a vessel, as defined in the

 California Harbors and Navigation Code, or a windsurfer, sailboard, or

 similar device within a swimming area which has been marked by means

 of buoys or to operate same within one hundred (100) feet of such area at

 a speed in excess of five (5) miles per hour.

§63.20.22 Abandoning Boats and Other Property Prohibited, Mooring and Anchorage Regulated

- (a) Except as otherwise permitted by this Code and except as may be permitted by the Director, it is unlawful:
 - (1) To allow vessels, boats, vehicles, or trailers to remain unattended in any beach area, including the waters thereof and Mission Bay Park.
 - (2) To moor or anchor any vessel, or for the owner thereofof a vessel to allow itthat vessel to be moored or anchored, whether occupied

- or unoccupied, between the hours of ten (10:00) o'clock p.m. and seven (7:00) o'clock a.m. in any area of Mission Bay Park.
- (3) To moor or anchor any vessel, or for the owner of a vessel to allow that vessel to be moored or anchored, and leave that vessel unoccupied for more than two hours in Zuniga Jetty Shoals. For purposes of section 63.20.22, Zuniga Jetty Shoals means the area within the following Global Positioning System coordinates:

- (b) Any vessel, boat, vehicle, or trailer left in violation of Section 63.20.22(a) may be removed by the Director without notice and any cost of removal and storage of saidthat property may be recovered by Thethe City of San Diego from the owner or any other person responsible for a violation of this Section, section 63.20.22. Nothing herein shallin this section will prevent impounding of a vessel as may be authorized by the California Harbors and Navigation Code or by this Code.
- (c) Upon impounding a boat or vessel under the authority of Subsection subsection 63.20.22(b), the Director shallwill, within ten-(10) calendar days of the impounding, send a registered notification letter to the owner of record advising of the impounding and what actions the owner may take to reclaim the property. If inadequate identifying information is available

on the impounded property, no notification is required. If the owner of the property fails to appear and pay all fees owed the City within ninety (90)thirty calendar days of the impounding of the property and pay all fees, the property shallwill be subject to removal, destruction, sale, or other disposal by the Director at the expense of the owner or owners and without any liability to the City for any damage to any property of the owner or owners.

- (d) Any sunken or abandoned <u>vessels</u>, rafts, wharves, buildings, or other obstructions found upon any beach area <u>within the City of San Diego</u>, including the waters thereof and Mission Bay Park, may be removed, destroyed, sold, or otherwise disposed of by the Director at the expense of the owner or owners and without any liability <u>to the City</u> for any damage to any property of the owner or owners.
- (e) The City may recover from the owner of any vessel, boat, vehicle, trailer,

 raft, wharf, building, or obstruction all City costs incurred as a result of

 any violations of this section, including costs associated with the clean-up

 or repair of damaged City property.

§63.25.1 Same — Definitions

"Commercial Vessel" through "Personal Watercraft" [No change in text.]

"Vessel" includes every description of watercraft used or capable of being used as

a means of transportation on water has the same definition as in the California Harbors and Navigation Code.

"Waters of Mission Bay" [No change in text.]
