DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUN 27 2019

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING ONE PROGRAM COORDINATOR POSITION IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

WHEREAS, on February 8, 2019 the San Diego Civil Service Commission (Civil Service Commission) reviewed a request from the Police Department (Department) to exempt a Program Coordinator position from the Classified Service of the City of San Diego (City); and

WHEREAS, the Program Coordinator position will be responsible for developing, coordinating, and managing cyber security policies and procedures for the Department; and

WHEREAS, the Program Coordinator position will work with the City’s Cyber Security Team to evaluate and support information compliance; oversee policies, procedures, and guidelines related to cyber security for Department networks and systems; ensure security is built into new and existing projects and initiatives; make decisions on future cyber security architecture, design, and incident response; and manage and monitor security and internal controls; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states the Unclassified Service shall include “[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council”; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the Program Coordinator position, as described by the Department, the Civil Service Commission found it meets the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding by the Civil Service Commission is set forth in the memorandum dated February 20, 2019 to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council, prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Charter section 117, the Department initiated advisory review and comment from the Civil Service Commission related to the proposed exemption of a Program Coordinator position from the Classified Service. On February 8, 2019, the Civil Service Commission reviewed the proposed exemption and commented favorably upon it as meeting Charter section 117 criteria for placement of the Program Coordinator position in the Unclassified Service. Having considered and reviewed the finding of the Civil Service Commission, as set forth in the memorandum dated February 20, 2019 to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council, prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, the Council now exempts from the Classified Service the Program Coordinator position in the Department, performing the duties described in the memorandum, and declares the position to be in the Unclassified Service.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.


