AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING ONE PROGRAM MANAGER POSITION IN THE HUMAN RESOURCES DEPARTMENT FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

WHEREAS, on July 11, 2019, the San Diego Civil Service Commission (Civil Service Commission) reviewed a request from the Human Resources Department (Department) to exempt one Program Manager position from the Classified Service of the City of San Diego (City); and

WHEREAS, the position will serve as liaison to all City departments by providing guidance and policy advice on labor and employment issues; advise departments on grievance resolution, disciplinary actions and appeals, and federal and state employment and labor laws; participate in labor negotiations and analyze proposals before meeting and conferring with impacted employee organizations; and develop labor relations policies such as memorandum of understanding language related to wages, hours, and other terms and conditions of employment, department work standards, work schedules and agreements with employee organizations; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the one Program Manager position as described by the Department to the Civil Service Commission, the Civil Service Commission found it meets the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding by the Civil Service Commission is presented to the Council as set forth in the memorandum dated July 15, 2019 to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council, prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Charter section 117, the Department initiated advisory review and comment from the Civil Service Commission related to the proposed exemption of one Program Manager position from the Classified Service. On July 11, 2019, the Civil Service Commission reviewed the proposed exemption and commented favorably upon it as meeting Charter section 117 criteria for placement of the Program Manager position in the Unclassified Service. Having considered and reviewed the finding of the Civil Service Commission, as set forth in the memorandum dated July 15, 2019 to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council, prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, the Council now exempts from the Classified Service the Program Manager position identified in the memorandum by the Department, performing the duties described in the memorandum, and declares the position to be in the Unclassified Service.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage. APPROVED: MARA W.
