A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND TRADE CORRIDOR ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM GRANT FUNDING FOR THE OTAY MESA TRUCK ROUTE PHASE IV PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 established the Trade

Corridor Enhancement Program, which provides grant funding for infrastructure improvements

along designated corridors with high volumes of freight movement; and

WHEREAS, the Otay Mesa Port of Entry crossing is the largest commercial crossing on the California-Mexico border; and

WHEREAS, the Otay Mesa Truck Route Phase IV Project (Project) will expand and widen the Southbound Truck Export Road, which is a dedicated one-way surface transportation access road used for all laden and empty freight trucks; and

WHEREAS, the Project will improve freight truck accessibility to the Otay Mesa Port of Entry, reduce traffic congestion on local streets, and improve safety; and

WHEREAS, the Project is eligible to receive \$6,000,000 in funding from the Trade Corridor Enhancement Program; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to apply to the Trade Corridor Enhancement Program for grant funding not to exceed \$6,000,000 for the Otay Mesa Truck Route Phase IV Project and take all actions necessary to secure the grant funding.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend an amount not to exceed \$6,000,000 if the grant funding is secured.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing account for the grant funding, if required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the Capital Improvement Program Budget in CIP S-11060, Otay Mesa Truck Route Phase IV, and to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$6,000,000, Trade Corridor Enhancement Program grant funding, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement.
