A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE GENERAL PLAN TO REDESIGNATE LAND LOCATED AT 1579-1645 MORENA BOULEVARD FROM COMMERCIAL EMPLOYMENT, RETAIL AND SERVICES, AND RESIDENTIAL TO A RESIDENTIAL DESIGNATION AND AN AMENDMENT TO THE CLAIREMONT MESA COMMUNITY PLAN TO REDESIGNATE LAND FROM LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL, MOBILEHOME PARK, AND GENERAL COMMERCIAL TO MEDIUM DENSITY RESIDENTIAL FOR THE MORENA APARTMENT HOMES PROJECT.

WHEREAS, Fairfield SD Coastal LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, requested an amendment to the General Plan to change the designated land uses on Figure LU-2, *General Plan Land Use and Street System*, for the site located at 1579-1645 Morena Boulevard (Project Site) from Commercial Employment, Retail and Services, and Residential to Residential; and

WHEREAS, a request was also made to amend the Clairemont Mesa Community Plan to redesignate the Project Site from Low Density Residential, Mobilehome Park and General Commercial to Medium Density Residential and to remove the Mobilehome Park Overlay Zone designation for the Project Site and the references to preservation of the existing Coastal Trailer Villa recreational vehicle park from the plan; and

WHEREAS, the site is legally described as those portions of Parcel 1 and Parcel 2 of Pueblo Lot 256, of the Pueblo Lands of San Diego, in the City and County of San Diego, State of California, according to Map thereof made by James Pascoe in 1870, filed in the Office of the County Recorder November 14, 1921, and is known as Miscellaneous Map 36; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the City of San Diego found the proposed amendment consistent with the General Plan, and the Clairemont Mesa Community Plan; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 280(a)(2) this resolution is not subject to veto by the

Mayor because this matter requires the City Council to act as a quasi-judicial body and where a

public hearing was required by law implicating due process rights of individuals affected by the

decision and where the Council was required by law to consider evidence at the hearing and to

make legal findings based on the evidence presented; and

WHEREAS, the project scope includes a Municipal Code and Local Coastal Program

Amendment to remove the site from the Mobilehome Park Overlay Zone; and

WHEREAS, on January 8, 2019, the City Council of the City of San Diego held a public

hearing for the purpose of considering an amendment to the General Plan and the Clairemont

Mesa Community Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered all maps, exhibits, and

written documents contained in the file for this project on record in the City of San Diego, and

has considered the oral presentations given at the public hearing; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that it adopts the

amendments to the General Plan, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as

312173\_1, and the Clairemont Mesa Community Plan, a copy of Document No. RR-
