A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DENYING THE APPEAL AND APPROVING THE ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION THAT THE MARIJUANA PRODUCTION FACILITY PROJECT AT 8390 MIRAMAR PLACE IS EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) PURSUANT TO GUIDELINES SECTION 15301 (EXISTING FACILITIES).

WHEREAS, on October 23, 2018, a Notice of Right to Appeal (NORA) for the marijuana production facility project at 8390 Miramar Place (Project) was prepared and posted pursuant to San Diego Municipal Code Section 112.0310; and

WHEREAS, on November 1, 2018 and November 6, 2018, environmental appeals were filed by Bill Fleischer and Willie F Senn, respectively; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Analysis Section of the Developmental Services

Department (DSD) determined the Project to be categorically exempt from the California

Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA State Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) and determined that the exceptions to the exemption do not apply; and

WHEREAS, under San Diego Charter section 280(a)(2), this resolution is not subject to veto by the Mayor because this matter requires the City Council to act as a quasi-judicial body and where a public hearing was required by law implicating due process rights of individuals affected by the decision and where the City Council was required by law to consider evidence at the hearing and to make legal findings based on the evidence presented; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the appeals of the environmental determination of the Project are denied, based on the substantial evidence provided in the record to support the exemption and the determination that no substantial

evidence has been provided to support a fair argument that one of the exceptions to the categorical exemption applies.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Environmental Exemption No. 585648 for the Project is approved and the Project is exempt from CEQA, pursuant to CEQA State Guidelines Section 15301.
