A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL OF THE INCREASE OF USER FEES FOR MONTH-TO-MONTH TIEDOWN TENANTS AT MONTGOMERY-GIBBS EXECUTIVE AIRPORT IS STATUTORILY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTIONS 15273(a)(1), 15273(a)(3), AND 15273(a)(4).

WHEREAS, Real Estate Assets Department - Airport Division, an enterprise fund, is seeking to increase the user fees for month-to-month tiedown tenants at Montgomery-Gibbs Executive Airport from \$0.11 per square foot to \$0.12 per square foot, effective as of July 1, 2019 (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California State Legislature, through the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code sections 21000-21177, has determined that CEQA does not apply to various types of projects listed therein; and

WHEREAS, California Public Resources Code section 21084 states that CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15260-15285 list the statutory exemptions promulgated by the California State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has determined that the Project is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15273(a)(1), 15273(a)(3), and 15273(a)(4); and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, onJAN 29 2019, the Council held a duly noticed public meeting
and considered the written record for the Project as well as any public comment; and
WHEREAS, the Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project
is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15273(a)(1),
15273(a)(3), and 15273(a)(4); NOW, THEREFORE,
BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that the Project is statutorily
exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15273(a)(1), 15273(a)(3), and
15273(a)(4).
