A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE VIA SOUTHWESTERN COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT, OFFICIAL GRANTEE, TO FUND COLLABORATIVE EFFORTS TO TRAIN CAMPUS LAW ENFORCEMENT IN INVESTIGATIONS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, STALKING, AND SEXUAL ASSAULT; TO RAISE STUDENT AWARENESS AND EDUCATION; AND TO PROSECUTE THESE CRIMES.

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Attorney's Office's Criminal Division's Domestic Violence and Sex Crimes Unit (SDDV) prosecutes misdemeanor crimes of domestic violence, stalking, and sex crimes that occur within the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, SDDV also conducts outreach to raise awareness and to educate the community about domestic violence, stalking, and sex crimes; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice (DOJ), Office on Violence Against Women (OVW) issued a grant solicitation that focuses on ways to reduce sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence and stalking on college campuses; and

WHEREAS, SDDV, along with lead agency Southwestern Community College District, four local colleges, and the Center for Community Solutions, collectively submitted a competitive proposal to the OVW responding to the grant solicitation; and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2018, the OVW awarded the grant to the lead agency, Southwestern Community College District, in the amount of \$750,000 over 3 years; and

WHEREAS, SDDV as a subrecipient of this grant, is entitled to \$249,980 in total personnel costs and \$12,767 toward travel costs; and

WHEREAS, this grant enables SDDV to work with community partners and local colleges to train campus law enforcement to improve investigations in domestic violence, stalking, and sexual assault; to raise student awareness and increase education regarding these issues; and to vertically prosecute these crimes; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego accepts and authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$265,000 from Southwestern Community College District as lead agency under the OVW grant.
