A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY OR GENERAL WELFARE REQUIRES THE FORMATION OF UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICTS IN RESIDENTIAL BLOCKS ON SAMPSON ST. (UU602), REDWOOD ST. (UU611), HILLTOP DR. PH II (UU616) AND FAIRMOUNT AVE. (UU628).

WHEREAS, Council Policy 600-8, "Underground Conversion of Utility Lines by Utility Company" further governs the undergrounding of utilities; and
