A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO GRANT THREE UTILITY EASEMENTS TO SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC ON CITY-OWNED REAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN MISSION BAY PARK AND MISSION VALLEY PRESERVE IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15301.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is considering the grant of three utility easements encompassing approximately five acers of real property located in Mission Bay Park and Mission Valley Preserve, and identified as portions of Assessor's Parcel Numbers 435-480-16, 435-480-17, 436-660-20, 436-660-29, and 436-680-05 (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code sections 21000-21177), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (title 14, sections 15000 to 15387 of the California Code of Regulations) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project, and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 as the actions involve the operation, maintenance, or repair of existing public or private facilities, with negligible or no expansion of use.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
