DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAR 25 2019

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING \$6,145 TO BURN INSTITUTE FOR THE SENIOR SMOKE ALARM PROGRAM, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, titled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903 (July 7, 2011); and

WHEREAS, Council Policy 100-06 provides a procedure and uniform requirements for awarding funds to and contracting with non-profit organizations and public agencies for one-time community, social, environmental, cultural, or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Burn Institute has requested funding for the Senior Smoke Alarm Program; and

WHEREAS, the requested funding will be used to purchase smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors that will be installed in senior households throughout the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the Burn Institute's request for funding for the Senior Smoke Alarm Program will benefit the public by saving lives and allowing firefighters to focus on aspects of fighting fires other than entering homes that are on fire, putting themselves at risk; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06; and

WHEREAS, Council Districts 2, 5 and 6 recommend a total allocation of \$6,145 to the Burn Institute for the purposes set forth in this resolution, attributed as follows: Council District 2 - \$1,500; Council District 5 - \$1,645, and Council District 6 –\$3,000; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocation described in this resolution is made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 3(g), which provides: “An organization may not apply to receive funding for an event or program which has already occurred, nor any capital improvement, goods, supplies, materials, or equipment which have already been purchased.”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a Community Projects, Programs, and Services FY 2019 City Council Allocations Agreement between the City of San Diego and the Burn Institute (Agreement) in an amount not to exceed \$6,145 for the project described in this resolution, under terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 312277 .

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$1,500 from Council District 2: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center No. 1102110002 GL512059; \$1,645 from Council District 5: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center No. 1105110005 GL512059; and \$3,000 from Council District 6: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center No. 1106110006, for a total of \$3,000, all to provide funds for the above-referenced Agreement, contingent upon the Chief

Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
