A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ADOPTING NEGATIVE DECLARATION NO. 503848 FOR UNIVERSITY MANOR MIXED USE – PROJECT NO. 503848.

WHEREAS, on June 22, 2017, University Avenue Manor, LLC submitted an application to the Development Services Department for a Site Development Permit, Planned Development Permit, Tentative Map, Public Right-of-Way Vacation, and Easement Vacation for the University Manor Mixed-Use (Project); and

WHEREAS, the matter was set for a public hearing to be conducted by the City Council of the City of San Diego; and

seq.), that the Declaration reflects the independent judgment of the City of San Diego as Lead

Agency and that the information contained in said Declaration, together with any comments

received during the public review process, has been reviewed and considered by the City Council

of the City of San Diego in connection with the approval of the Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council finds on the basis of the entire

record, including the Initial Study and any comments received, that there is no substantial

evidence that the Project will have a significant effect on the environment, and therefore, that

said Declaration is hereby adopted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Declaration and other documents constituting

the record of proceedings upon which the approval is based are available to the public at the

Office of the City Clerk, 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of

Determination with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego regarding

the Project.
