A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE PLANNING DEPARTMENT'S FEE AND DEPOSIT SCHEDULE AND TAKING RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, the schedule of fees and deposits for the Planning Department (Planning) has been historically incorporated into fee studies and schedules prepared by the Development Services Department, but with the separation and re-establishment of Planning as its own department in fiscal year (FY) 2015 Planning proposes to formally establish its own comprehensive fee and deposit schedule (Schedule); and

WHEREAS, Planning proposes an increase in the General Plan Maintenance Fee (GPMF) from \$275 to \$450 per applicable permit application and the ability to increase the GPMF annually in accordance with inflation; and

WHEREAS, Planning proposes increases in the Hourly Project Review Fees to reflect changes in position cost and indirect cost rate calculations as determined by the Department of Finance:

WHEREAS, the Schedule otherwise consists of existing fees and deposits with unchanged amounts; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That Planning's Schedule, reflecting existing fees and deposit amounts and the aforementioned increases to the GPMF and Hourly Project Review Fees as set forth in the document on file with the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-312295, is hereby approved.

- 2. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to apply an annual inflationary adjustment to the General Plan Maintenance Fee at the beginning of each fiscal year at the rate set by the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for all items in San Diego-Carlsbad, CA, all urban consumers, not seasonally adjusted (Series ID: CUURS49ESA0, CUUSS49ESA0) as published by the United State Department of labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, for May of each year.
- 3. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to take all necessary actions to appropriate expenditures and revenues and to expend funds as published in the Schedule.
- 4. That the Schedule shall be effective sixty days after the final passage of this resolution.
