A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE EXECUTION OF THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE LEASE AGREEMENT WITH AARDEMA FAMILY LIMITED PARTNERSHIP, A CALIFORNIA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP, FOR THE REAL PROPERTY LOCATED AT 411 RAVEN STREET, SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA TO BE USED BY THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15301.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) is considering executing a First Amendment to Standard Industrial/Commercial Single-Tenant Lease – Net between the City, as lessee, and Aardema Family Limited Partnership, a California Limited Partnership, as lessor, for the lease of the real property located at 411 Raven Street, San Diego, California consisting of fenced yard and improved with a 30,000 square foot building with office and warehouse space and two small storage sheds (Property) for use by the Parks and Recreation Department (Project); and

WHEREAS the City has leased the Property from Aardema and the Parks and Recreation

Department has occupied the Property since 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Property is used by the City's Parks and Recreation Department for storage, repair, and maintenance of equipment and for office purposes; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code sections 21000-211177), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines (title 14, sections 15000 to 15387 of the California code of Regulations) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 (Existing Facilities) and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 because it involves the leasing of existing private property, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of the agency's determination, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has considered the written record and public comment for the requested authorization, and determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA

Guidelines Section 15301, and that an exception to	the exemption as set forth in CEQA
Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.	}
