A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT FISCAL YEAR 2020 SLURRY PROJECTS ARE EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINE SECTION 15301(C).

WHEREAS, the Transportation & Storm Water Department plans to authorize the list of Fiscal Year 2020 projects to be funded by the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA) and advertise, award, and execute street maintenance contracts for Slurry Seal Group 1924, Slurry Seal Group 1925, Slurry Seal Group 2021, and Slurry Seal Group 2022, to provide for the repair and sealing of approximately 240 miles of asphalt streets located throughout the City (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of repairing and sealing of asphalt streets located throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, on APR 18 2019, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment because it resurfaces or paves existing thoroughfares; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that Fiscal Year 2020 Slurry Projects are categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301(C).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
