A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DENYING THE APPEAL OF THE HISTORIC DESIGNATION OF THE HENRY B. JONES HOUSE AT 4114 IBIS STREET AND UPHOLDING THE DECISION TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY AS AN HISTORIC RESOURCE.

WHEREAS, on November 20, 2009, the San Diego Historical Resources Board (HRB) designated the Henry B. Jones house at 4040 Fifth Avenue (Property) as an historic resource; and WHEREAS, Scripps Health filed an appeal of the historic designation on December 4, 2009; and

WHEREAS, in July 2018, Scripps Health relocated the Property to 4114 Ibis Street pursuant to Site Development Permit No. 1906434; and

WHEREAS, Scripps Health wishes to withdraw and no longer proceed with its appeal, but the hearing is required to be held because the San Diego Municipal Code does not have a provision expressly mooting a hearing in cases where an appeal is withdrawn; and

WHEREAS, on appeal, the City Council may affirm, reverse, or modify the determination of the HRB; and

WHEREAS, the City Council may reject the HRB's designation of a property as a historic resource on the basis of factual errors in materials or information presented to the HRB, violations of bylaws or hearing procedures by the HRB or an individual member, or the presentation of new information; and

WHEREAS, no evidence has been cited to support any of the grounds for the withdrawn appeal, whether factual error, procedural violations, or new information, and City staff accordingly recommends denial of the appeal; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that there is no basis to reject the HRB's designation

of the property as an historic resource; and

WHEREAS, under San Diego Charter section 280(a)(2), this resolution is not subject to

veto by the Mayor because this matter requires the City Council to act as a quasi-judicial body

and where a public hearing was required by law implicating due process rights of individuals

affected by the decision and where the City Council was required by law to consider evidence at

the hearing and to make legal findings based on the evidence presented; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the appeal is

denied, and the designation of the Property as an historic resource is upheld.
