DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAY 17 2019

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SPEND UP TO \$9,500,000 OVER FIVE YEARS FOR THE CITY'S SHARE OF THE TOTAL COST FOR ACCESS TO THE AUTOMATED REGIONAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the Automated Regional Justice Information System (ARJIS) is administered by the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) and is a system through which law enforcement and justice agencies throughout San Diego and Imperial Counties share information; and

WHEREAS, SANDAG administers ARJIS through a Joint Powers Agency (JPA); and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) has utilized ARJIS for over thirty years, and has been a member of the JPA, as currently formed, since 2004 (San Diego Resolution R-299315 (Jun. 7, 2004)); and

WHEREAS, ARJIS provides an invaluable resource to law enforcement officers in the City by providing information which can be used to solve crimes, identify suspects, and enhance officer and public safety; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to remain a member of the JPA and desires continued access to ARJIS and the benefits it provides; and

WHEREAS, as a member of the JPA, the City, through the San Diego Police Department (Department), is individually charged on an annual basis for its share of the total cost of administration, operation, and maintenance of the applications provided by ARJIS, as well as for access to these systems; and

WHEREAS, the City's share of the ARJIS fees are projected not to exceed \$9,500,000 over a five-year period; and

WHEREAS, these fees are recurring annual charges and will be proposed in the Department's operating budget for each corresponding fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the annual cost to the City is paid through a purchase order each year after ARJIS has calculated each member agency's final share of the total costs; and

WHEREAS, the JPA is an agency, as defined in San Diego Municipal Code (Municipal Code) section 22.3003; and

WHEREAS, agreements with agencies are exempt from competitive bidding by Municipal Code section 22.3208(g); and

WHEREAS, City Council approval of this agreement is required based on the projected amount of the annual and total fees, in accordance with Municipal Code section 22.3206(d) and section 22.3210(c); NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the City is authorized to remain a member agency of the ARJIS JPA for five additional years, from July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2024.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to continue to pay the City's share of the annual JPA member agencies costs and fees from July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2024 for continued access to and use of ARJIS computer applications.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$9,500,000, from the General Fund (100000), over five years, from July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2024, for the City's annual share of the cost for continued ARJIS JPA membership and associated user fees, contingent upon the adoption of the annual Appropriation

Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing a certificate certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.


