A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 8, ARTICLE 6, DIVISION 1 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 83.0137, RELATING TO VEHICLE HABITATION IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTIONS 15061(b)(3) AND 15304(e).

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) desires to adopt an ordinance amending Chapter 8, Article 6, Division 1 of the San Diego Municipal Code amending section 86.0137 relating to using a vehicle for habitation (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15061(b)(3) and 15304(e) and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential

environmental effects of the Project, and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the

written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent

judgment, has considered the written records and public comment for the requested action, and

determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines

sections 15061(b)(3) and 15304(e) and that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA

Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
