A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO PURSUANT TO SECTION 147(f) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986 APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR 14TH AND COMMERCIAL APARTMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of San Diego (Authority) intends to issue not to exceed \$101,000,000 aggregate principal amount of multifamily housing revenue bonds (Bonds) in one or more series, pursuant to a plan of finance, to finance or refinance the acquisition, construction and equipping of "14th and Commercial Apartments," a 326-unit multifamily rental housing development to be located in the City of San Diego (City) described in the Notice of Public Hearing attached as Exhibit A hereto (Project); and

WHEREAS, in order for interest on the Bonds to be tax-exempt, section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (Code) requires that the Bonds be approved by the City Council as the applicable elected representative after a public hearing following reasonable public notice; and

WHEREAS, one or more notice(s) of a public hearing with respect to the proposed issuance of the Bonds were timely published in accordance with said section 147(f); and

WHEREAS, the public hearing was held on May 14, 2019, and an opportunity was provided for interested persons to express their views on the issuance of the Bonds and on the nature and location of the Project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego that this City Council, as the applicable elected representative under section 147(f) of the Code, approves the issuance of the Bonds by the Authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City does not warrant the creditworthiness of the Bonds or guarantee, in any way, the payment of the Bonds. No moneys of the City will be pledged or applied to the repayment of the Bonds.

The facilities are to be owned by 14th & Commercial CIC LP, a California limited partnership, or a partnership of which Chelsea Investment Corporation and/or SVDP Management Inc. The 326-unit Project is expected to include 93 units for low-income and very-low income tenants, plus 230 units for very low-income and low-income individuals experiencing homelessness with an identified disability. The Project will be part of a larger multifamily residential development to be located at the Project site, which is expected to include a total of 2 buildings comprised of approximately 407 affordable rental units, including the Project.
