Fees FY 2018 Annual Report, that the documentation: (1) Identifies the purpose to which the fee is to be put; (2) Demonstrates a reasonable relationship between the fee and the purpose to which the fee is to be put; (3) Identifies sources and amounts of funding anticipated to complete financing of incomplete improvements; and (4) Identifies the approximate dates on which such funding is expected to be deposited into the appropriate fund.
