A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ADOPTING THE WATER SUPPLY ASSESSMENT FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, SAN DIEGO – HILLCREST LONG RANGE DEVELOPMENT PLAN UPDATE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) Public Utilities Department (PUD) prepared a Water Supply Assessment (WSA) for the University of California, San Diego Hillcrest Long Range Development Plan Update Project (Project) to comply with the requirements of California Senate Bill 610, ratified by the California State Water Code Section 10910; and

WHEREAS, a WSA evaluates water supplies that are, or will be, available during a normal, single-dry year, and multiple-dry water years during a 20-year projection to meet the Project's demands in addition to existing and planned future water demands of the PUD; and

WHEREAS, the overall WSA process was completed in consultation with the Development Services Department (DSD), the San Diego County Water Authority (SDCWA), and the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California (MWD), and was conducted in compliance with the requirements under California Senate Bill 610; and

WHEREAS, the University of California, San Diego's Hillcrest Campus (Campus) is located within the City's Uptown Community Plan Area within the Medical Complex neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the Project calls for redevelopment of the Campus through the creation of five new districts: Health Care, Residential, Open Space, Mixed-Use and Canyon, for an increase to the campus area of 1,612,500 gross square feet as a result of district improvements; and

WHEREAS, the WSA demonstrates there will be sufficient water supplies available

during normal, single-dry year, and multiple-dry water years over 20-years to meet the projected

level of water demand for this Project in consideration of regional water resource planning

documents of the City, SDCWA, and MWD; and

WHEREAS, based on these findings, the Project for which the WSA was completed in

December 2018 will result in no unanticipated demands and provides an assessment of the

availability of water supplies for the Project only for use in an environmental impact review, and

does not constitute approval of the Project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego adopts the WSA for the

Project to fulfill the requirements of California State Water Code section 10910, under the terms

and conditions set forth in the document, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No.
