WHEREAS, since 2009, the City of San Diego, through the Office of the City Attorney, has been awarded a non-competitive grant from the State Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board (State Agency) to fund a Criminal Restitution Compact Specialist position in the Criminal Division; and

WHEREAS, the most recent grant provides an amount of funding of \$78,586 annually and not to exceed total of \$235,758.00 for a three-year period from July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the grant agreement between the State Agency and the City of San Diego, through the Office of the City Attorney (Grant Agreement), is intended to establish a positive, collaborative relationship for effective operation of California's criminal restitution system; and

WHEREAS, this action would authorize the City of San Diego, through the Office of the City Attorney, to enter into a new Grant Agreement with the State Agency to continue to fund a Criminal Restitution Compact Specialist position during the time period of July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2022, in an amount not to exceed \$235,758; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Council approves the acceptance of a grant in an amount not to exceed \$235,758 to fund the Criminal Restitution Compact Specialist position in the Criminal Division of the Office of the City

Attorney, for the period from July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2022 on the terms and conditions outlined in Standard Agreement Number VC9077, a copy of which is on file with the City Clerk's Office as Document No. RR-312522.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Attorney is authorized to execute all agreements necessary, including any amendments, to comply with the renewed grant requirements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend up to \$78,586 per year in grant funds from the State Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board, for the purpose of funding the Criminal Restitution Compact Specialist position in the Office of the City Attorney, Criminal Division, for a three-year period, from July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2022, for a total not to exceed amount of \$235,758.00, contingent upon a fully executed Grant Agreement and provided that the Chief Financial Officer certifies that the funds are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing fund for the grant money.
