A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CONFIRMING APPOINTMENTS AND REAPPOINTMENTS TO THE SUSTAINABLE ENERGY ADVISORY BOARD.

WHEREAS, the Sustainable Energy Advisory Board is established in San Diego
Municipal Code section 26.04 as an advisory body to the Mayor, City Council, and City
Manager on energy policy and future energy needs for the metropolitan San Diego area, and to
assist the City's attainment of energy independence and renewable energy goals; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code requires the Mayor to appoint nine regular members (seven designated members and two at-large members), as well as two at-large alternate members, who are all to be confirmed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code requires the seven designated members to be appointed from the following representative areas of organizational interest, expertise, and background:

- (1) San Diego Regional Energy Office (SANDAG)
- (2) San Diego Gas & Electric Company
- (3) Environmental Advocate
- (4) Labor Organization
- (5) Solar Power System Manufacturer or Installer
- (6) Building Industry
- (7) Chamber of Commerce/Business Community; and

WHEREAS, the two at-large representatives and two at-large alternates are to be appointed at the discretion of the Mayor and subject to Council confirmation; and

WHEREAS, members shall serve two-year terms and each member shall serve until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the following appointments and reappointments by the Mayor of the City of San Diego, to serve as members of the Sustainable Energy Advisory Board, for terms ending as indicated, are made and hereby confirmed:
