A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AN AS-NEEDED CONSULTANT AGREEMENT WITH SCS ENGINEERS, INC. TO PROVIDE SERVICES FOR COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE GREENHOUSE GAS REGULATIONS AT CITY OF SAN DIEGO LANDFILLS; AND RELATED FUNDING ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego's (City) Environmental Services Department requires the as-needed consulting services (Consulting Services) of an environmental and engineering consulting firm in order to provide compliance with applicable local, state and federal greenhouse gas (GHG) regulations at City landfills; and

WHEREAS, in February 2018, in conformance with Administrative Regulation 25.60 and Council Policy 300-07, the City advertised a Request for Proposals for the Consulting Services and received one responsive proposal from SCS Engineers, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the City evaluated the proposal from SCS Engineers, Inc. and determined that SCS Engineers, Inc. is highly qualified to provide the Consulting Services; and

WHEREAS, the City selected SCS Engineers, Inc. to provide the Consulting Services, subject to City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, the Environment Committee heard this item on June 13, 2019, and unanimously recommended that the City Council approve the contract award to SCS Engineers, Inc.; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, an agreement with SCS Engineers, Inc., for as-needed consulting services to provide compliance with applicable local, state and federal GHG regulations at City landfills, for a period of five years, in an amount not to

exceed \$1,500,000, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file with the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 312553.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000 from the Refuse Disposal Fund No. 700039, solely and exclusively to provide funds for the Agreement, contingent upon City Council approval of the annual Appropriations Ordinance for the applicable fiscal years, and upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend \$1,000 from the Refuse Disposal Fund No. 700039, for the purpose of executing the Agreement and meeting minimum contract requirements.
