A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT APPROVAL OF AN ASNEEDED CONSULTANT AGREEMENT WITH SCS ENGINEERS, INC. TO PROVIDE SERVICES FOR COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE GREENHOUSE GAS REGULATIONS AT CITY OF SAN DIEGO LANDFILLS IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15306.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego's (City) Environmental Services Department requires the as-needed consulting services (Consulting Services) of an environmental and engineering consulting firm in order to provide compliance with applicable local, state and federal greenhouse gas (GHG) regulations at City landfills; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into a five year agreement with SCS Engineers, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000, to provide the Consulting Services in order to provide compliance with applicable local, state and federal GHG regulations at City landfills; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects that have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and that shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects that have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

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WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Project is

categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15306 (Information

Collection), and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section

15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential

environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego held a duly noticed public meeting and

considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has

determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment as the Project is

an agreement for as-needed consulting services that does not result in a serious or major

disturbance to an environmental resource; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the Project

is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15306.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines

that an exception to the exemption pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
