A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE WATER SUPPLY ASSESSMENT FOR THE PARK AND BROADWAY PROJECT IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15061(B)(3).

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), states that CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300 – 15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego desires to adopt the Water Supply Assessment for the Park and Broadway Project to fulfill the requirements of California State Water Code Section 10910; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has established that the approval of the Water Supply Assessment for the Park and Broadway Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3) and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to CEQA Section 15352(a), approval of the Project, which

includes improvements to the Property, does not constitute approval of the project for which a

future discretionary action and environmental document would be required. This action will not

foreclose review of alternatives or mitigation measures by the public as part of any future CEQA

process. Formal approval of a future project will occur once an environmental review has been

completed in accordance with the provisions of CEQA Section 15004 and the City's Land

Development Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the potential environmental effect of the

Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the

written record for the Project as well as public comment; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent

judgment, has considered the written record and public comment for the Water Supply

Assessment for the Park and Broadway Project, and determines that the Project is categorically

exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3), under the general rule

that CEOA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on

the environment.
