A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO SELL BY NEGOTIATION CERTAIN EXCESS CITY PROPERTY LOCATED AT 415 EUCLID AVENUE, SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, IDENTIFIED AS ASSESSOR'S PARCEL NUMBER 548-040-39; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS TO CONSUMMATE THE SALE; AND AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO ACCEPT AND DEPOSIT THE INDEPENDENT CONSIDERATION AND THE PROCEEDS OF THE SALE IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTIONS 15312.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is considering the sale of the approximately .621 acres of real property, improved with an approximately 7,000 square foot building, located at 415 Euclid Avenue, San Diego, CA 92114, identified as Assessor's Parcel Number 548-040-39 (Property) and other related actions (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000, et seq.), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000, et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has established that the Project is categorically

exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15312 and that no exception to the

exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) has considered the potential

environmental effects of the Project, and

WHEREAS, the Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written

record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project

will not have a significant effect on the environment because it is the sale of surplus government

property which is not located in an area of statewide, regional, or area wide concern identified in

CEQA Guidelines section 15206(b)(4) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15312; NOW,

THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the Project

is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15312, and that an

exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
