A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE GENERAL PLAN AND LINDA VISTA COMMUNITY PLAN.

WHEREAS, on August 1, 2019, the City Council of the City of San Diego held a public hearing for the purpose of considering an amendment to the Linda Vista Community Plan and General Plan, and other actions associated with the Morena Corridor Specific Plan; and

WHEREAS, the current Linda Vista Community Plan was adopted in 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the City of San Diego held a public hearing on February 21, 2019, to consider the proposed Morena Corridor Specific Plan and associated amendments to the Linda Vista Community Plan and Local Coastal Program Land Use Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission recommended certification of Final Environmental Impact Report Project No582608/SCH No. 2016101021 prepared for the proposed Morena Corridor Specific Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council found, based on its hearing record, that the proposed Linda Vista Community Plan amendment is consistent with and implements the City of San Diego's General Plan; that the proposed plan amendment helps achieve long-term community and citywide goals; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered all maps, exhibits, and written documents contained in the file for this project on record in the City of San Diego, and has considered the oral presentations given at the public hearing; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego that it adopts the amendment to the General Plan and Linda Vista Community Plan, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 312608.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that prior to becoming effective, this resolution shall be submitted to the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority (SDCRAA) for a consistency determination.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if the SDCRAA finds this resolution consistent with the Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan (ALUCP) for San Diego International Airport (SDIA), this resolution shall take effect after the finding of consistency or the date that

O-______ adopting the Specific Plan becomes effective, whichever is later.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if the SDCRAA determines that this resolution is inconsistent or conditionally consistent, subject to proposed modifications, with the ALUCP for the SDIA, the resolution shall be submitted to the City Council for reconsideration.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if the SDCRAA determines that this resolution is conditionally consistent with the ALUCP for the SDIA, but that consistency is subject to proposed modifications, the City Council may amend this resolution to accept the proposed modifications, and this resolution as amended shall take effect and be in force on the date of its 21122 adopting the Specific Plan becomes effective, whichever is later.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a proposed decision by the City Council to overrule a determination of inconsistency or to reject the proposed modifications for a finding of conditional consistency shall include the findings required pursuant to Public Utilities Code section 21670 and require a two-thirds vote. The proposed decision and findings shall be

forwarded to the SDCRAA, the California Department of Transportation, Division of Aeronautics, and the airport operators for the SDIA. The City Council shall hold a second hearing not less than 45 days from the date the proposed decision and findings were provided, at which hearing any comments submitted by the public agencies shall be considered and a final decision to overrule a determination of inconsistency shall require a two-thirds vote.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if the City Council makes a final decision to overrule a determination of inconsistency, this resolution shall take effect and be in force on the date of its final passage or the date that O-______ adopting the Specific Plan becomes effective, whichever is later.
